- 15 December – Call for Application
- 15 January 2021 – Deadline for Submission of Applications
- Approx. end of February/March – Decision by the partner departments, communication of results

Application

- Application form
- Letter of Motivation
 - 2-3 Pages
 - Relevance for your studies/Master thesis
- CV
 - Chronological including a passport photo
- Languages Certificates
 - If other than English
 - Especially important for Fudan (Mandarin) and Yaoundé (French)

Funding

- Erasmus+ (Non-European Program)
 - coordinated by Leipzig University
- PROMOS
 - Funded by the DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service)
 - coordinated by Leipzig University
- National Programs (like AuslandsBafög)

Further Information

- Exchange plans and courses need to be **approved by Second Year University!**
- No tuition fees, but sometimes additional **administrative fees** (e.g. Stellenbosch)
- Erasmus Mundus Scholarship holders are not allowed to study in home country
- Please apply only after careful consideration! Take into account especially your financial and social (and health) situation and that you have to write your **Master Thesis** in the 4th semester.
